Candidates must have a minimum cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent. Scholarship candidates will be reviewed on leadership, character, communication skills, and scholastic average.

Please Note: Undergraduate scholarships are awarded in May, 2012 for the upcoming 2012-2013 academic school year.

Master Degree Scholarships

Purpose: To support the costs of attending a masters program towards an accounting or finance degree.

Criteria: Scholarship awards are presented to students who are currently enrolled in a master's degree program by time of the application deadline and are majoring in accounting or finance. Candidates must have a minimum cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent. Scholarship candidates will be reviewed on leadership, character, communication skills, and scholastic average.

Please Note: Master scholarships are awarded in May, 2012 for the upcoming 2012-2013 academic school year.
